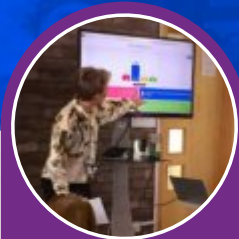


## TACKLING

This aims to improve the financial efficiency of the police force offering an **opportunity for investment in police officer numbers**.

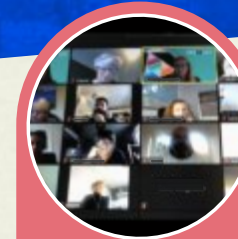


## SUPPORTING
