

CONSERVATIVE BUDGET CHAOS IN BCP

Conservative-run BCP Council has been deep in **financial chaos**. Its **Leader recently resigned**. This all follows **debt-piling**, and Government blocking a **“dodgy deal”** to keep BCP solvent by selling off local beach huts. This has now led to the **maximum 4.99% Council Tax rise** for 2023/24, plus **£32.9m of cuts** including to the **communities team**.

Alasdair Keddie commented: **“Local Conservative mismanagement of the budget** has now resulted in the need for **cuts across services**. Meanwhile **vanity projects** such as beach BBQs and a Freeport bid **were prioritised**.

“We need a budget which works for the residents of BCP and the sustainable future of our three towns.”

OUR PLAY AREAS NEED IMPROVEMENT



The **play areas in Cyril Park and Queen’s Park** are **looking tired**, with equipment removed or in need of repair and replacement.

Nicole says: “These play areas are a **vital resource for local families**. Our priority would be to improve these facilities. **Local children deserve better.**”

Greens successfully pressed the Council to make improvements to the **Mallard Road play park**.

POOLE HARBOUR OIL SPILL “RISKS WILDLIFE, TOURISM AND JOBS”



On Sunday 26th March 2023, a **major incident was declared** following an **oil spill in Poole Harbour**.

Hard-working local campaigner **Alasdair Keddie spoke** at a well-attended **community protest** the next day. BCP’s Green councillors also attended.

Reckless oil extraction in Poole Bay poses an **unacceptable risk to our local wildlife, tourism and jobs**. The recent oil spill is just one of a string of incidents in recent years at **Poole’s Wytch Farm – Europe’s largest oilfield**.

Alasdair Keddie said: “Wytch Farm is **years past its intended lifespan**. Local **Green councillors you elect this 4th May** will push for it to be **decommissioned urgently.**”
