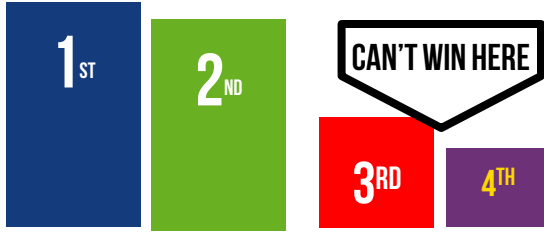


IT'S KATE & JOE OR THE CONSERVATIVES

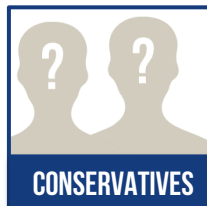
"I want to be a genuine voice for the people of Moordown and make sure that our area is well cared-for. Local residents deserve a decent standard of council services."

Joe is an experienced community advocate and works in the NHS.

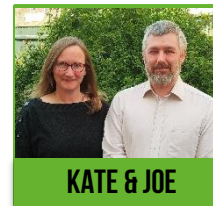
