With nearly 10% of Moordown residents living without internet access, we need to make sure vital services are still accessible for all.

Councillors Chris Rigby and Simon Bull were 2 of only 17 councillors present at the February full council meeting who



voted against the Conservative budget with the remaining 54 Councillors voting for or abstaining.

Commenting, Chris Rigby said: "The Conservative mismanagement of the budget since they took administration has resulted in the need for cuts across services including the communities team. Whilst vanity projects such as beach BBQs and freeport bids were prioritised. We need a budget which works for the residents of BCP and the sustainable future of our three towns".
